Night-of-Event Volunteer Opportunities for **RIDERS**

- I will volunteer and ride for \$25. Volunteer Course Marshals ride for \$20.*
- On-the-route Course Marshal** (guiding riders at an assigned intersection and enforcing Rules of the Road; check in at Buckingham Fountain Medical Tent at 11pm)
- On-bike medic/first-aid volunteer** (check in at Buckingham Fountain Medical Tent at 11pm)
- On-site registration at Buckingham Fountain** from midnight-2am (check in at your assigned tent at 10:30pm)
- Breakfast serving** (4am-6am at Buckingham Fountain)*
- Equipment set-up** (6pm-10:30pm at Buckingham Fountain)
- Tear-down/clean-up** (5am-9am at Buckingham Fountain)

* All riding volunteers are asked to help with breakfast serving after completing the ride.

Night-of-Event Volunteer Opportunities for **NON-RIDERS**

- Q&A/Lost & Found** at Buckingham Fountain from ___ 10pm-2am or ___ 2am-sunrise
- Tear-down/clean-up** (5am-9am at Buckingham Fountain)
